

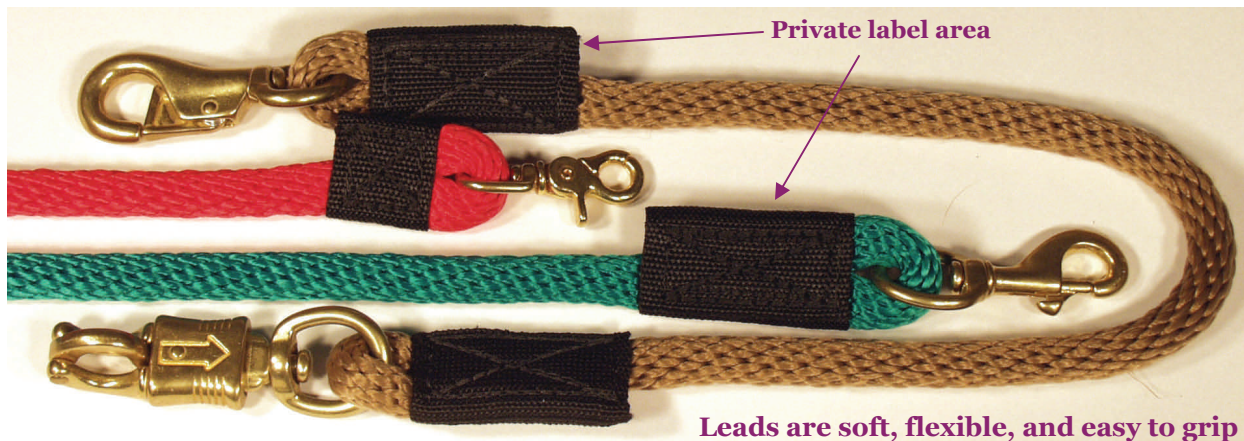
Horse Leads

While working with volunteer product testers, we found that horse trainers wouldn't use nylon rope because it will rope burn, and especially as the rope ages it will cause slivers that can lodge in your hands. Cotton rope hasn't worked well either, because the color fades quickly and it is heavy, especially if it gets wet. We did testing until we came up with a weave that is soft on the hands, as well as easy on the horse's coat. This polypropylene product stays soft and pliable even in cold conditions, and it won't sliver. This lightweight product will float in water and is easy to clean. It also releases knots easier than nylon or cotton ropes.
